Commitment to the Kids

The Mo-Town Grapplers Club uses donations to give back to the kids who make this program a success.

- Wrestling Academy – The Club provides a team membership to a local wrestling academy. Wrestlers are able to attend three two-hour sessions each week during the year.
- Traveling Team Scholarship – The Mo-Town Grapplers Club pays for 50% of a wrestler’s registration fee for a traveling wrestling team during the off-season.
- Essay Scholarship Program – Wrestlers going into 6-8th grade are eligible to apply for a scholarship by writing an essay. This program sends kids to a one-week summer wrestling camp, which balances teaching technique and competition, readying the kids for the coming season’s competition.
- New wrestling mats, equipment, uniforms.
- Insurance premiums and league fees.
